

ORDINANCE NO. 2602

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO DISPENSE WITH AN ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 222.120 O.R.S., REGARDING THE ANNEXATION OF A PORTION OF BLOCK 2, KURRE LAKESIDE TRACTS, CONTIGUOUS WITH THE CITY OF ALBANY, SETTING A TIME OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of July, 1958, there was filed with the City Recorder of the City of Albany, a petition and consent by the petitioners, Harold E. Hansen and Doris L. Hansen, representing to be the owners of the property, contiguous to the City of Albany, Oregon, to elect to dispense with an election within the City of Albany concerning the annexation of the said property and setting a date for Public Hearing of the same.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That an election within the City of Albany regarding the annexation of the following described property, to-wit:

Beginning South 1025' East 81.06 feet from the South-east corner of Block 2, Kurre Lakeside Tracts, Section 5, Township 11, S. Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, Linn County, Oregon;  
thence South 1025' East 200 feet to the Northwesterly right of way of the relocated Pacific Highway;  
thence along the said right of way on a 5669.58 foot radius to the left of the long chord of which bears South 59°25'40" West 410.74 feet a distance of 410.83 feet to a point 20 feet East of the West line of the Anderson Cox D.L.C. No. 49 in said Township and Range;  
thence North 1025' West parallel to the West line of said Claim No. 49, a distance of 200 feet;  
thence North 59°25'40" East 410.74 feet to the place of beginning and containing 1.65 acres more or less.

and shall be and it is hereby dispensed with pursuant to and under the terms of Section 222.120 O.R.S.

Section 2: That there shall be a Public Hearing as to the advisability of annexing the property described in Section 1 to the City of Albany, on the 27th day of August, 1958, and the City Recorder is hereby directed to give notice of said Public Hearing by publishing in a newspaper of general circulation, published in the said City once a week for two (2) successive weeks and by posting in four (4) public places, a notice setting forth the time and place of the said hearing and the description of the property to be considered for annexation and the purpose for which the hearing is held.

Section 3: Whereas, it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of the property described herein be disposed of at the earliest possible moment, and should the same be annexed, that the City facilities be made available to this property, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
