

ORDINANCE NO. 2828

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF THIRTIETH AVENUE AND THIRTY-FIRST AVENUE,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany did, by the adoption of Resolution No. 514 at the Council meeting held on the 23rd day of December 1958, set the hour as 7:15 p.m. o'clock Pacific Standard Time on February 11, 1959 as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of Thirtieth Avenue and Thirty-first Avenue, more particularly described in the said Resolution and did in the said Resolution direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, notice has been posted and published as required by law and in the said Resolution, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 11th day of February, 1959 was duly held and no remonstrance having been filed with the City Recorder and no persons appearing objecting to the proposed vacation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

That a portion of Thirtieth Avenue and Thirty-first Avenue more particularly described as follows:

All of 30th Avenue and 31st Avenue  
which lies between South Madison  
Street and the West boundary line  
of Rodgersdale Addition to the City  
of Albany, Linn County, Oregon

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street in the City of Albany, Oregon.
