

ORDINANCE NO. 2869

TITLE: An Ordinance to amend Section 23 of Ordinance No. 2751 and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDMENT

Section 23 of Ordinance 2751 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 23: PARKING METER HOODS & BARRICADE OF PARKING SPACES

The City Recorder may issue parking meter hoods to contractors engaged in the construction, re-construction or repair of a building or installation of equipment and building adjacent to a street where parking meters are installed. Such hood shall be issued only when available, unmetered area, including alleys which might be used or blocked off without interference with commerce, are not found reasonably close to the place where such persons are engaged and shall be issued only for use for each particular construction job. A deposit of \$1.00 shall be paid for each parking meter hood when issued and this deposit shall be refunded upon return of the parking meter hood. There shall be an additional charge of 50¢ per day or \$2.00 per week for each day or week the hood shall be in use, upon proof of a continuing need. In the event that parking spaces are barricaded during the course of construction so that they shall not be available for the use of parking by the general public, there shall be a charge of 50¢ per day or \$2.00 per week per parking space made to the person erecting the barricade."

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires this Ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become in full force immediately upon final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
