ORDINANCE NO. 2884

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO DISPENSE WITH AN ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY PURSUANT TO 222.120 ORS REGARDING ANNEXATION OF AREA 1 - LEHIGH ADDITION AND ADJACENT AREA; SETTING A TIME FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

RECITALS:

Whereas, it has heretofore been determined to hold an election in an area herein described for the purpose of determining whether or not the residents of that area desire to be annexed to the City of Albany,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FULLOWS:

Section 1: DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

That an election within the City of Albany for the purpose of annexing the following described property, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the present city limits line, said point being the intersection of the N. line of Queen Ave. and the W. line of Oak St.; thence Easterly along the N. line of Queen Ave. extended to Geary St.; thence Easterly along the N. line of county road to Waverly Drive; thence Northeasterly to the S.W. corner of that property described in Book 250, Page 331 of Linn County Deed Records; thence Easterly along the S. property line of said property and along the S. boundary of that property described in Book 237, Page 28, Linn County Deed Records, to the State Hwy. right-of-way; thence Northerly to a point on the city boundary line, which point is the intersection of the S. margin of Franklin and the W. margin of Airport Rd.; thence Westerly; thence Southerly; thence Westerly; thence Northerly; thence Westerly limits line, to Waverly Drive; thence along present city limits line to point of beginning,

shall be and is hereby dispensed with pursuant to and under the terms of 222.120 ORS.

Section 2: TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING - NOTICES

That there shall be held a public hearing as to the advisability of annexing Area 1, Lehigh Addition and adjacent areas, to the City of Albany on the 23rd day of December, 1959, at the hour of 7:15 o'clock p.m. in the City Hail, Albany, Oregon, and the City Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to give notice of the said public hearing by publishing in a newspaper of general circulation in said city once a week for two (2) successive weeks prior to the election and by posting a notice in four (4) public places for the same length of time setting forth the time and place of said hearing and the description of the property to be considered for annexation and the purpose for which the hearing is held.

Section 31 EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Whereas, it is for the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of property described herein be disposed of at the earliest possible moment and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become

immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
