

ORDINANCE NO. 2924

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AN OPEN SEASON FOR HUNTING OF PHEASANTS ON THE CITY OF ALBANY AIRPORT, PROVIDING REGULATIONS, ESTABLISHING PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: It shall be lawful to hunt pheasants on the City of Albany Airport property during the following times: 6:15 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. on October 29, 1960.

Section 2: The City Manager shall prepare rules and regulations governing hunting on the airport property and shall insure compliance.

Section 3: Any person violating any rules covering hunting on airport property as published by the City Manager shall forfeit the right to hunt on airport property and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$50.00.

Section 4: Inasmuch as it is necessary that this ordinance become effective as soon as possible in order to eliminate a danger to air traffic now existing on airport property because of the excessive number of game birds, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall become in full force and effect upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
