

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO DISPENSE WITH AN ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY PURSUANT TO 222.120 ORS REGARDING ANNEXATION OF A PORTION OF FIR OAKS 2ND ADDITION; SETTING A TIME FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

RECITALS:

Whereas, there has heretofore been filed with the City Recorder of the City of Albany petitions by persons representing themselves as owners or equitable owners of property in Lots 65 and 66 of Fir Oaks 2nd Addition, requesting the Council of the City of Albany elect to dispense with an election within the City of Albany for annexing a portion of Fir Oaks 2nd Addition and requesting that a date be set for hearing on the said proposal,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

That an election within the City of Albany for the purpose of annexing the following described property, to-wit:

Lots 65 and 66

shall be and is hereby dispensed with pursuant to and under the terms of 222.120 ORS.

Section 2: TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING -- NOTICES

That there shall be held a public hearing as to the advisability of annexing that portion of 2nd Addition to Fir Oaks described in Section 1, to the City of Albany on the 24th day of October, 1962, at the hour of 7:15 o'clock P.M. in the City Hall, Albany, Oregon, and the City Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to give notice of the said public hearing by publishing in a newspaper of general circulation in said City once a week for two (2) successive weeks prior to the election and by posting a notice in four (4) public places for the same length of time setting forth the time and place of said hearing and the description of the property to be considered for annexation and the purpose for which the hearing is held.

Section 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Whereas, it is for the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of property described herein be disposed of at the earliest possible moment and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
