

AN ORDINANCE VACATING HARRISON STREET BETWEEN FIRST AVENUE AND WATER STREETS

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany did, by the adoption of Resolution No. 713 at the Council meeting held on the 14th day of November, 1962, set the hour as 7:15 p.m. o'clock on December 12, 1962 as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of Harrison Street, between First Avenue and Water Streets, more particularly described in the said Resolution and did in the said Resolution direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, notice has been posted and published as required by law and in the said Resolution, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 12th day of December, 1962 was duly held and parties were given opportunity to be heard and Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

All that portion of Harrison Street between First Avenue and Water Streets, more particularly described as follows:

All that portion of Harrison Street that lies between the intersection of Water Street and First Avenue in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon,

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street in the City of Albany, Oregon.
