

ORDINANCE NO. 3127

TITLE: An ordinance providing for the date and manner of holding a special election in the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 12th day of June, 1964, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of the City of Albany the following proposal: Shall the City of Albany increase the tax levy for the fiscal year 1964-65 over the amount limited by Section 11 of Article XI of the Constitution of Oregon. The amount in excess of the 6% limitation proposed to be levied for the said fiscal year is the sum of \$94,999.00, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: SPECIAL ELECTION CALLED.

The proposition set forth in Section 2 of this ordinance shall be submitted in the manner prescribed in this ordinance to the legal voters of the City of Albany, Oregon, at a special election to be held on the 12th day of June, 1964, said election commencing at 8 o'clock a.m. of said day and continuing until 8 o'clock p.m. of said day.

Section 2: PROPOSITION TO BE VOTED.

At the election there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Albany, for their approval or rejection, the following proposition:

"Shall the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, increase the tax levy for the fiscal year 1964-65 over the amount limited by Section 11, Article XI of the Constitution of Oregon by a sum not to exceed \$94,999.00."

Section 3: DESIGNATION OF POLLING PLACES.

The following are hereby designated as the voting places for the said election:

First Ward	Mapel School
Second Ward	City Hall
Third Ward	Waverly School

Section 4: DESIGNATION OF JUDGES AND CLERKS OF SPECIAL ELECTION.

Designation of judges and clerks of special election to supervise the election at each of the within wards of the City of Albany shall be as follows:

Section 5: QUALIFICATION OF JUDGES AND CLERKS.

The judges and clerks shall qualify by subscribing to an oath in the manner and form provided by law and in case any of such officers shall fail to attend, then those present shall elect another to act in his place.

Section 6: HOURS OF ELECTION.

The polls for the special city election shall be open in each of the polling places at the hour of 8 o'clock a.m. and shall be kept open until 8 o'clock p.m. on the same day.

Section 7: NOTICE OF ELECTION.

Notice of this election shall be given by publication twice in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Albany, Oregon, not more than fifteen (15) days, nor less than five (5) days before the election. Notices of the election shall be posted for not less than ten (10) days before the election in three (3) public places within the city. The notice in the newspaper and those posted in three (3) public places shall be in substantially the following form:

"NOTICE OF ELECTION

On the 12th day of June, 1964, in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, from 8 o'clock a.m. until 8 o'clock p.m., a special election will be held at which time the following measure shall be submitted to the voters for their approval:

'Shall the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, increase the tax levy for the fiscal year 1964-65 over the amount limited by Section 11, Article XI of the Constitution of Oregon by the sum of \$94,999.00?

'REASON: The reason for increasing such levy is:

Insufficient tax base to provide for requirements necessary for the public health, peace and safety of the Citizens of the City of Albany.


