

ORDINANCE NO. 3142

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF SOUTH WALNUT STREET BETWEEN TWENTY-FIRST AND TWENTY-SECOND AVENUES

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Albany did by motion of the Council at the Council meeting held on the 10th day of June, 1964, set the hour as 7:15 p.m. o'clock on July 22, 1964, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of South Walnut Street between 21st and 22nd Avenues, as hereinafter described and did direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS the said hearing on the 22nd day of July, 1964, was duly held and parties were given opportunity to be heard and Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: All that portion of South Walnut Street between 21st and 22nd Avenues, more particularly described as follows:

All that portion of S. Walnut Street between 21st and 22nd Avenues in South Albany Addition to Albany, Linn County, Oregon

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street in the City of Albany, Oregon.


