

ORDINANCE NO. 3156

TITLE: An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 2751, Section 51 thereof, as the same pertains to bicycle licenses and annual license fees.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDMENT

Section 51. No person, who resides within this City, shall ride a propelled bicycle on any street or upon any public path set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles, unless such bicycle has been licensed. Application for such license shall be made to the Chief of Police who may issue a license which shall be effective until the next succeeding first day of January, providing applicant submits satisfactory proof of ownership of the bicycle and evidences reasonable knowledge of the traffic safety rules. An annual license fee of 50¢ shall be paid to the City before each license or renewal thereof is granted."



