ORDINANCE NO. 3164

AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE ASSESSMENTS AGAINST THE PROPERTY SPECIFICALLY BENEFITED BY THE SOUTH INDUSTRIAL SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION NO. 3, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

RECITALS:

- 1. The sewer assessment as referred to in this ordinance and previous resolutions and ordinances is "South Industrial Sanitary Sewer Extension No. 3."
- 2. Preliminary resolutions and ordinances prescribing the manner and extent of the improvement are set forth in Resolution Nos. 769 and 774 and in Ordinance No. 2864.
- 3. The assessments set forth in the following ordinance are based upon the request and recommendation of the City Engineer in compliance with Ordinance No. 2864.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: COST

The total cost of the sewer construction for the South Industrial Sanitary Sewer Extension No. 3 is hereby determined to be \$13,533.68. The following tabulation represents a breakdown of the costs to be assessed against the property particularly benefited thereby:
