

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING TO DISPENSE WITH AN ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 222.110, 222.120 AND 222.170 ORS, REGARDING THE ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY ADJACENT TO 34TH AVENUE, CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, SETTING A TIME FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS 100 per cent of the owners of the property which is the subject matter of this annexation have petitioned and requested the City of Albany to annex the area hereinafter described to the city and the same being contiguous to and in all respects qualifying under the present statutes for annexation, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Albany that a public hearing be held at the earliest possible date to consider objections to the annexation of the property herein described,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

That an election within the City of Albany regarding the annexation of the following described property, to wit:

Tract 54, Fir Oaks Addition, City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon:
ALSO: Beg at a 1/4" iron rod at the NE corner of Tract 54, Fir Oaks 2nd Add. to Albany, Linn County, Oregon; and running thence S 0°26' W along the E line of sd Tract 208.08' to a 1/2" iron rod; th S 89°34' E 25.0' to a 1/2" iron rod; th N 0°26' E parallel to the E line of sd tract 197.31' to a 1/2" iron rod; th N 66°19' W 27.21' to pob
EXCEPT: Beg on the E line of and S 0°26' W 208.08' from NE corner Tract 54, Fir Oaks 2nd Addn; th N 89°34' W 101.07' to W line of sd tract; th S 0°26' W 75' of SW corner of said tract; th S 66°19' E 110' to SE corner of said tract; th N 0°26' E 118.42' to beg.

be dispensed with.

Section 2: HEARING

That there shall be a public hearing as to the advisability of annexing the property described in Section 1 to the City of Albany on the 13th day of July, 1966, at 7:15 p.m. o'clock, and the City Recorder is hereby directed to give notice of said public hearing by publishing in a newspaper of general circulation, published in the said City once a week for two (2) successive and consecutive weeks and by posting in four (4) public places, a notice setting forth the time and place for said public hearing and the description of the property to be considered for annexation and the purpose for which the hearing is held.

Section 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of the property hereinabove described be disposed of at the earliest possible moment, and should the same be annexed, that the city facilities be made available to this property, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
