

ORDINANCE NO. 3258

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3063; BEING AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ALBANY SAFETY COUNCIL; PERTAINING TO SECTION 2 THEREOF, ESTABLISHING MEMBERSHIP, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDMENT

That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 3063 be amended to read as follows:
Membership of the Albany Safety Council shall consist of seven (7) members to be appointed by the Mayor, subject to the ratification of the City Council.

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, the peacem health, safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that a safety council be established at the earliest possible date, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
