

ORDINANCE NO. 3264

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING FOR THE CITY OF ALBANY, LINN COUNTY, OREGON, THE 1964 EDITION OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE AS PUBLISHED BY INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS; REPEALING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 3058, CITY OF ALBANY ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: ADOPTION OF CODE IN THIS ORDINANCE

The Uniform Building Code, 1964 Edition, prepared and adopted by the International Conference of Building Officials, Pacific Coast Building Officials Conference Subsidiary, is hereby adopted, accepted and passed as the building code in and for the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon as though the same were fully set forth herein and this reference to the said code makes it a part of this Ordinance.

Section 2: CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED

That Ordinance No. 2787 and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Albany that this ordinance shall become immediately operative, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
