

ORDINANCE NO. 3295

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 3292, CITY OF ALBANY ORDINANCES, SEGREGATING THE LIEN OF ROBERT F. AND LADORA DALY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 3292 be amended to read as follows:

1. South 40 ft. of Tract 5, Southern Addition to Morningside Tracts \$1,029.65 and the 20 ft. strip along the south line of said tract.

Section 2: The City Recorder is hereby directed to enter the amended changes of specified Section 1 in the dockets of the City liens.
