

ORDINANCE NO. 3333

AN ORDINANCE TO ASSESS PROPERTY FOR SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENT PREVIOUSLY CONSTRUCTED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

RECITALS:

1. The assessment set forth in the following ordinance is based upon the request and recommendation of the City Engineer in compliance with Ordinance No. 2864.
2. The sanitary sewer referred to in this ordinance and previous resolution is known as the Goltra Park Sanitary Sewer Extension 1-A.
3. Preliminary resolution and ordinance prescribing the manner and extent of improvement are: Resolution No. 1051, Ordinance No. 3276 and No. 2864.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

The total cost of a portion of the sewer construction for the Goltra Park Sanitary Sewer Extension 1-A to be assessed against the property, heretofore unassessed because the property was not adjacent to the sewer line as constructed, is \$426.50.
