

ORDINANCE NO. 3371

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF 15TH AVENUE IN EPAULINE ADDITION
TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, LINN COUNTY, OREGON

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany did by Resolution No. 1133, passed by the Council at the Council Meeting on the 25th day of September, 1968, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. on the 13th day of November, 1968, as the time of hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of 15th Avenue located in Epauline Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, notice has been posted and published as required by law in the said resolution, and

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on the 13th day of November, 1968, and no remonstrance was filed with the City Recorder, and no persons appearing objecting to the proposed vacation of portion of street, now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:


That a portion of 15th Avenue located in Epauline Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

15th Avenue from the East side of Lafayette Street between Lot 2, Block 4 and Lot 1, Block 9 of Epauline Addition to the City of Albany and extending to terminus at the Western boundary of Lots 8 and 9, Block 3, Hillway Addition, approximately 60 feet, Except, the City of Albany does reserve an easement of 5 feet along the east line of vacated 15th Avenue for utility purposes over and under the said vacated street and does retain the right to go upon the premises to install, replace or repair sewers, water lines or other public utilities on a 10 ft. access easement on the South line of portion of vacated 15th Avenue to run Easterly from East side of Lafayette St. to the West boundary of Hillway Addition.
