

ORDINANCE NO. 3453

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF HARRISON STREET AND CLEVELAND STREET IN THE CITY OF ALBANY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1210, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 22nd day of October, 1969, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on the 26th day of November, 1969, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of Cleveland Street and Harrison Street, as hereinafter described, and did direct the City Recorder to publish and post notices of the said proposed vacations as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 26th day of November, 1969, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That portion of Harrison Street between Block 1 and Block 10 of Hackleman's 4th Addition to the City of Albany, and that portion of Cleveland Street between Block 10 and Block 11 of Hackleman's 4th Addition to the City of Albany beginning at a pt of 100 ft North of the SW corner of said Blk 11, th continuing N to the Willamette River, be and the same is hereby vacated.
