

ORDINANCE NO. 3501

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7.44.040 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE AS THE SAME PERTAINS TO MINORS IN BILLIARD ROOMS OR POOL ROOMS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDMENT

Section 7.44.040 of the Albany Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Visiting Card Rooms. It is unlawful for any minor to enter, visit or loiter about any card room unless the minor is delivering merchandise at the request of the operator of the premises. It is unlawful for any person operating or assisting in the operation of any card room to permit any minor to enter, visit, or loiter about any such premises."

Section 2: EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany is involved, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become in full force and effect immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
