

ORDINANCE NO. 3513

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTION 2.24.180 PROHIBITING POLITICAL ACTIVITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 2.24.180 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"No city employee shall take an active part in a city political management or a city political campaign involving the election of a city official without first resigning his position with the city. No city employee shall directly or indirectly solicit or receive or be in any manner concerned in the soliciting or receiving of any assessments, subscriptions, contributions, either voluntary or involuntary, for any political purpose connected with the City of Albany. All employees shall retain the right to vote as they choose and express their opinions on political subjects and candidates."

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Albany that this Ordinance shall become immediately operative and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
