

ORDINANCE NO. 3568

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF RAILROAD STREET LYING BETWEEN 27TH AND 28TH AVENUE, RESERVING SEWER EASEMENTS, SAID STREET IN BLOCK 1, ANSLEY PARK ADDITION

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, did, by Resolution No. 1310, passed by the Council at the council meeting on the 28th day of April, 1971, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on June 9, 1971, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of street, a portion of Railroad Street lying between 27th and 28th Avenue; Reserving a sanitary sewer easement of 6 ft. on either side of the existing sewer running east and west through Block 1, Ansley Park Addition; Also Reserving a 10 ft. storm sewer easement adjacent to the West line of Lot 1, Block 1, Ansley Park Addition; Also Reserving a storm sewer easement 5 ft. on either side of the center line of said Railroad Street on the south one-half of the block between 27th and 28th Avenues, and

WHEREAS, notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 9th day of June, 1971, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed, now, therefore,


THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a portion of Railroad Street lying between 27th and 28th Avenues; Reserving a sanitary sewer easement of 6 ft. on either side of the existing sewer running east and west through Block 1, of Ansley Park Addition; Also Reserving a 10 ft. storm sewer easement adjacent to the West line of Lot 1, Block 1, Ansley Park Addition; Also Reserving a storm sewer easement 5 ft. on either side of the center line of said Railroad Street on the south one-half of the block between 27th and 28th Avenues, be and the same is hereby vacated.
