

ORDINANCE NO. 3602

AN ORDINANCE VACATING ALLEY IN BLOCK 8, WINONA PARK ADDITION,  
RESERVING UTILITY EASEMENT OF TEN FEET

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, did, by Resolution No. 1366, passed by the Council at the council meeting on the 8th day of December, 1971, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on January 12, 1972 at the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of an alley in Block 8, Winona Park Addition, located between Lafayette and Madison Streets, running from 12th Avenue North to the Railroad right-of-way, reserving utility easement of 16 feet, as herein described, and

WHEREAS, notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 12th day of January, 1972, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed, now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the alley in Block 8, Winona Park Addition, located between Lafayette and Madison Streets, running from 12th Avenue North to the railroad right-of-way, reserving utility easement of sixteen feet, be and the same is hereby vacated.
