

ORDINANCE NO. 3654

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE AN ASSESSMENT AGAINST PROPERTY LOCATED AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF LYON STREET AND SECOND AVENUE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY TO COVER THE AMOUNT OF THE EXPENDITURES INCURRED IN REMOVAL OF A NONCONFORMING SIGN AS PROVIDED IN ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE 18.32.310 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

The total cost of removing a sign from property commonly called Albany Hotel, located on the southwest corner of second avenue and Lyon street city of Albany more particularly described as follows:


Lot 4, Block 18, City of Albany Addition, (11 3W 6CC, Tax Lot 11700) is determined and found to be the sum of sixty-five (65) dollars.

Section 2:

Assessment entered on docket. The city recorder is hereby directed to enter a statement of assessment of \$65.00 as provided by law pursuant to the divisions of Albany Municipal Code 18.32.310 against the above described property in the docket of city liens and give notice therein as provided by law.

Section 3: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
