

ORDINANCE NO. 3680

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FAIR HOUSING ACT IN THE CITY OF ALBANY  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following enumerated fair housing laws of Oregon  
as heretofore or hereafter amended, are adopted by reference and made  
a part of this ordinance:

O.R.S. 659.031 and O.R.S. 659.033

Section 2. A person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance shall  
upon conviction thereof, be punished by imprisonment for a period not  
to exceed 30 days, or by a fine not to exceed \$500 or by both.

Section 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions  
are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation  
of the public peace, health and safety; and an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full  
force and effect from and after its passage.
