

ORDINANCE NO. 3712

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE WESTERLY FIVE FEET OF WIDTH AND THE EASTERLY FIVE FEET OF WIDTH OF SOUTH JEFFERSON STREET FROM THE SOUTH LINE OF EAST 24TH AVENUE TO THE NORTH LINE OF EAST 25TH AVENUE, EXCEPTING THAT THE CITY OF ALBANY SHALL RETAIN A PERPETUAL EASEMENT ON THE DESCRIBED PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1514 City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 23rd day of May, 1973, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on the 27th day of June, 1973, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of Jefferson Street from the south line of east 24th Avenue to the north line of East 25th Avenue, excepting that the City of Albany shall retain a perpetual easement on the described property.

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 27th day of June, 1973, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That the westerly five feet of width and the easterly five feet of width of south Jefferson Street from the south line of east 24th Avenue to the north line of east 25th Avenue be vacated, excepting that the city of Albany shall retain a perpetual easement on the described property.
