

ORDINANCE NO. 3751

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5.20.010 (b) AND SECTION 5.20.070 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO THE DEFINITION OF "MERCHANT POLICE" AND THE NECESSITY FOR FILING BOND.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

Section 5.20.010 (b) of the Albany Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

"(b) 'Merchant Police' means any person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of watching, guarding, or protecting any premises, property, or persons, provided, however, that the term does not include any individual who is employed directly by the owner of premises or property to watch, guard, or protect only the premises or property of the owner."

Section 2:


Section 5.20.070 of the Albany Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

"5.20.070 Bond. The licensee or applicant shall, before receiving a license, furnish a good and sufficient surety bond in the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) conditioned upon the faithful performance and honest conduct of himself and his employees who will be engaged in watching, guarding, or protective undertakings of the person, firm or corporation licensed hereunder. In the event that a licensee shall have several employees the bond required to be given under this section shall be for the licensee only, however, it shall be all inclusive as to any and all employees of the licensee. The bond shall be payable to the city and any other affected persons, business or corporation and shall guarantee payment of any judgment secured against the licensee or any of his agents for negligence, default or breach of conduct in the performance of duties authorized by the licensee up to the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00)."
