

ORDINANCE NO. 3815

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING AND NOTICE THEREOF TO CONSIDER WITHDRAWING CERTAIN ANNEXED TERRITORY FROM THE Albany Rural Fire Protection DISTRICT.

RECITALS: WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the city of Albany and the territory annexed by Resolution No. 1636 that such territory be withdrawn from the Albany Rural Fire Protection district; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the city of Albany desires to obtain further citizens' opinion on the subject of withdrawal as directed by state law to obtain such opinion; now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: PUBLIC HEARING.

A public hearing on the question of withdrawing SURROUNDED territory from the Albany Rural Fire Prot. district shall be held on the November 13th day of November, 1974 at 7:15 p.m. o'clock p.m. at the City Hall of the city of Albany.

Section 2: NOTICE.

The City Recorder shall cause notice of the hearing to be published once each week for two (2) successive weeks prior to the day of the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation within the city. The City Recorder shall also cause notice of this hearing to be posted in four (4) public places within the city for a like period of time.
