

ORDINANCE NO. 3936

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE DATE AND MANNER OF HOLDING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, LINN AND BENTON COUNTIES, OREGON, ON THE 24TH DAY OF JUNE, 1976, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR TEN (10) SEPARATE SPECIAL TAX LEVIES OUTSIDE OF THE 6% LIMITATION FOR THE YEAR 1976-77 TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES: OPERATION OF THE CITY BUS SYSTEM, OPERATION OF MOSQUITO CONTROL PROGRAM, PROVIDE FOR SENIOR CITIZEN CENTER COORDINATOR AND FUNDS FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE, PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL POLICE PERSONNEL, EQUIPMENT AND SALARIES, PROVIDE FOR ACQUISITION OF AN AMBULANCE, TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL FIRE FIGHTING AND AMBULANCE PERSONNEL, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ACQUISITION OF EQUIPMENT THROUGH A RESERVE EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT FUND, TO PROVIDE FOR PARK MAINTENANCE, TO PROVIDE FOR LIBRARY SERVICES, TO PROVIDE FOR GENERAL OPERATIONAL EXPENSES OF THE CITY: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: SPECIAL ELECTION CALLED.

That the propositions set forth in Section 2 of this ordinance shall be submitted in the manner prescribed in this ordinance to the legal voters of the City of Albany at a special election to be held on the 24th day of June, 1976.

Section 2: PROPOSITIONS TO BE VOTED.

(a) Shall the City of Albany levy a special one (1) year tax levy not to exceed the sum of \$40,000 outside of the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon Constitution for the tax year 1976-77, to provide funds for the operation of a city bus system?

(b) Shall the City of Albany levy a special one (1) year tax levy not to exceed the sum of \$56,500 outside of the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon Constitution for the tax year 1976-77 to provide funds for mosquito control?

(c) Shall the City of Albany levy a special one (1) year tax levy not to exceed the sum of \$17,000 outside of the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon Constitution for the tax year 1976-77 to provide funds with which to pay a Senior Citizens Center coordinator and operating and maintenance funds for the Senior Citizens Center?

(d) Shall the City of Albany levy a special one (1) year tax levy not to exceed the sum of \$152,500 outside of the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon Constitution for the tax year 1976-77 to provide funds for additional police personnel, equipment and police salaries?

(e) Shall the City of Albany levy a special one (1) year tax levy not to exceed the sum of \$40,000 outside of the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon Constitution for the tax year 1976-77 to provide funds for the acquisition of a city ambulance?

(f) Shall the City of Albany levy a special one (1) year tax levy not to exceed the sum of \$125,400 outside of the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon Constitution for the tax year 1976-77 to provide funds for equipment replacement through an equipment replacement reserve fund?

(g) Shall the City of Albany levy a special one (1) year tax levy not to exceed the sum of \$50,800 outside the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon Constitution for the tax year 1976-77 to provide funds for additional fire fighting personnel and additional ambulance personnel?

(h) Shall the City of Albany levy a special one (1) year tax levy not to exceed the sum of \$28,200 outside of the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon Constitution for the tax year 1976-77 to provide funds for general operating expenses of the City of Albany?

(i) Shall the City of Albany levy a special one (1) year tax levy not to exceed the sum of \$22,600 outside of the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon Constitution for the tax year 1976-77 to provide funds for park maintenance in the City of Albany?

(j) Shall the City of Albany levy a special one (1) year tax levy not to exceed the sum of \$22,600 outside of the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon Constitution for the tax year 1976-77 to provide funds for library services and maintenance in the City of Albany?

Section 3: DESIGNATION OF POLLING PLACES, POLL BOOKS AND JUDGES AND CLERKS OF ELECTION.

The polling places are hereby designated as follows:

Ward One	Maple School and Liberty School
Ward Two	Lafayette School and Church of the Nazarene
Ward Three	Waverly School and South Albany High School.

Section 4: HOURS OF ELECTION.

The polls for the special city election shall be kept open at the polling places from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.

Section 5: NOTICE OF ELECTION.

The notice of election shall be given by publication twice in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Albany not more than twenty (20) days nor less than ten (10) days before the election. Notice of the election shall be posted for not less than ten (10) days before the election in three (3) public places within the city. Notice in the newspaper and those posted in three (3) public places shall be in substantially the following form:

"NOTICE OF ELECTION

"On the 24th day of June, 1976, in the City of Albany, Linn and Benton Counties, Oregon, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., a special election shall be held at which time the following propositions shall be submitted to the voters for their approval:

(a) Shall the City of Albany levy a special one (1) year tax levy not to exceed the sum of \$40,000 outside of the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon Constitution for the tax year 1976-77, to provide funds for the operation of a city bus system?

The Recorder shall advertise and post or cause to be posted the notice required by this section. The notice of election required to be given by this ordinance shall constitute the only notice necessary and all ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith and shall not apply to the notice required by this section.
