ORDINANCE NO. 4109

AN ORDINANCE VACATING 29 PALMS ADDITION WHICH LIES WITHIN AN AREA BOUNDED BY KNOX BUTTE ROAD, TIMBER STREET, GOLD FISH FARM ROAD, & E. 2ND, AMENDING ORDINANCE #3876 IN ORDER TO VACATE THE ENTIRE PLAT, AND CHANGING THE NAME TO TIMBER LINN ADDITION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1938, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 8th day of Feb., 1978, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on the 8th day of March, 1978, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of the entire 29 Palms Addition and changing the name to Timber Linn Addition; and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 8th day of March, 1978, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

That Ordinance #3876 be amended in order to vacate the entire 29 Palms Addition lying within an area bounded by Knox Butte Road, Timber Street, Gold Fish Farm Road, and East Second and that the entire 29 Palms Addition Plat be vacated, and that the name be changed to Timber Linn Addition.
