

ORDINANCE NO. 4394

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.04 OF THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE BY THE ADOPTION OF 1979 MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

Chapter 13.04 of the Albany Municipal Code is amended by the addition thereto of Section 13.04.060, which shall read as follows:

"13.04.060 Amendment -- Adoption of 1979 Motor Vehicle Laws. Violation of the provisions contained in Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapters 481, 482, 483, 484, 485 and 487, as now or hereinafter constituted, shall be an offense against the City and prosecution and trial thereunder shall be as provided therein."

Section 2.

Inasmuch as it is necessary for the peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Albany, Oregon, that the above ordinance take effect as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
