

ORDINANCE NO. 4579

Title: An ordinance amending Section 1.04.010 of the Albany Municipal Code as it provides for penalty for violation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1.04.010 of the Albany Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

"1.04.010 Penalty for violation. Any person violating any of the provisions or failing to comply with any of the mandatory requirements of the ordinances of the City of Albany shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Any person convicted of a misdemeanor under the ordinances of the City of Albany shall be punished by a fine of not more than ~~five hundred dollars~~ **twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00)**, or by imprisonment not to exceed one (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each such person shall be guilty of a separate offense for each and every day during any portion of which any violation of any provisions of the ordinances of the City of Albany is committed, continued, or permitted by any such person, and he shall be punished accordingly."
