

ORDINANCE NO. 4709

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 13.04, ADOPTION OF STATE TRAFFIC ACT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Albany Municipal Code Chapter 13.04, Adoption of State Traffic Act is hereby amended to read as follows:

13.04.080 Adoption of 1985-86 Motor Vehicle Laws: Violation of the provisions contained in Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapters **801, 802, 803, 805, 806, 807, 809, 810, 811, 813, 814, 815, 816, 818, 819, 820, 821, 822, and 823**, shall be an offense against the City of Albany and prosecution and trial thereunder shall be as provided therein.

Section 2: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall become in full force and effect immediately on its passage by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
