

RESOLUTION NO. 336

WHEREAS, the Boxing and Wrestling Commission of the City of Albany has received during the fiscal year 1954-55 the total sum of \$550.74 as receipts from Wrestling Matches held in Albany, and

WHEREAS, the distribution of said funds is required by State Statute to be distributed among the Veterans Organizations and the City of Albany for charitable purposes on the basis of 60% to the Veterans Organizations and 40% to the City, and

WHEREAS, certifications have been received from the following Veterans Organizations as to their membership on May 1, 1955:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that 60% of the total receipts of the Boxing and Wrestling Commission be apportioned among the Veterans Organizations as follows:

Veterans of Foreign Wars	30.40
Marine Corps League	15.86

and be it further resolved that the City share of 40% in the amount of \$220.30 be transferred to the Swimming Pool Sinking Fund as provided by Ordinance No. 2571, and be it further resolved that the balance in the Boxing and Wrestling Fund being the City share of the receipts for previous years be transferred to the Swimming Pool Sinking Fund, said previous receipts totaling \$1,146.13.
