

RESOLUTION NO. 660

WHEREAS it has been recommended by the Parking Commission of the City of Albany that the two-hour parking restriction be removed on both sides of 5th Avenue from Ellsworth Street to Ferry Street; on both sides of Ferry Street from 4th Avenue to 5th Avenue; on the west side of Ellsworth Street from 4th Avenue to 6th Avenue; on the east side of Ellsworth Street from 4th Avenue to midway in the block between 5th Avenue and 6th Avenue; and on the south side of 5th Avenue from Ellsworth Street east to a point midway in the block between Ellsworth Street and Lyon Street, and the Council having fully investigated and being informed, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Albany that the two-hour restriction on parking as established by Resolution Nos. 331, 357 and 393, City of Albany Resolutions, be eliminated on both sides of 5th Avenue from Ellsworth Street to Ferry Street; on both sides of Ferry Street from 4th Avenue to 5th Avenue; on the west side of Ellsworth Street from 4th Avenue to 6th Avenue; on the east side of Ellsworth Street from 4th Avenue to midway in the block between 5th Avenue and 6th Avenue; and on the south side of 5th Avenue from Ellsworth Street east to a point midway in the block between Ellsworth Street and Lyon Street, and the same is hereby eliminated and said streets shall be used for unlimited parking.
