
WHEREAS, certain funds for this work may be available through the American Revolution Bicentennial Commission of Oregon for this work ,

We are submitting our grant application with as complete a detailed expense list as possible. Our income is hard to determine at present, so we have tried to estimate our expenditures and income as closely as possible. Many of the industries in our area have offered donations as soon as our project program is ready. Restoration is new for us, but our labor will be done mostly by ourselves. Repairs and special items will be contracted to more skilled businesses.

Once our equipment is restored, it will be placed in the City of Albany Fire Department Museum which is now being built and will be completed by July 1, 1975. At this time, we are planning an open house and dedication ceremony to kick off the Bicentennial of our Great Nation.

Please note, on February 19, 1975, we are having our first official meeting of Albany Engine Co. No. 1 to elect officers, write a constitution, and make application for a non-profit organization.
