

RESOLUTION NO. 1669

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon that there shall be initiated such proceedings as are necessary to vacate streets in Rulter's Addition in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, which is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to give notice of a public hearing on the proposed said vacation of streets as above described to be held in the Council Chambers at the City Hall, Albany, Oregon, on the 26th day of March, 1975, at the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock by publication of notice thereof once a week for four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Albany and by posting notice thereof at each end of the proposed vacation and at two places within the area of the proposed vacation, within five days of first publication date, said notice to set forth the time, place and purpose of said hearing and to contain a description of the streets proposed to be vacated.


Vacation of all streets in the Rutter's Addition south of the south line of Queen Avenue to wit:

Calapooia Street from south line of Queen South to terminus;
Vine Street from south line of Queen south to terminus except that portion lying within the State of Oregon R/W of Pacific Boulevard;
16th Avenue (now known as 19th Avenue) from Vine Street to Calapooia;
17th Avenue (Now known as 20th Avenue) from Vine Street to Calapooia;

All property adjacent to these streets are under one ownership or surrounded by the Santiam Albany Canal or the Southern Pacific Transportation Co. right-of-way.
