

RESOLUTION NO. 1724


WHEREAS, the Albany Parking and Safety Commission has met for study and recommends the following be adopted by the Albany City Council:

1. That a stop sign be placed at the intersection of 10th and Calapooia stopping 10th Avenue.
2. That a stop sign be placed at the intersection of 6th and Walnut stopping Walnut.
3. That 2-hour parking be established on the north side of Water Avenue to 110 feet west of Ferry Street and on Washington Street except for the existing loading zone area and 45' south of the existing curbs on the north end of the street.
4. To accept the recommendations of the OSHD for the changing of signalization at Queen and Hill Street and that in conjunction with the changes that parking be prohibited on the west side of Hill Street 90 feet north of the north line of Pacific Blvd.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of Albany, Oregon, that:


