

RESOLUTION NO. 1732

WHEREAS, the City of Albany owns the Adair Water System and such system has capacity to serve additional customers,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Albany hereby declares that it ~~will~~ make water service available subject to the following conditions:

1. All customers shall sign an annexation agreement prior to receiving service.
2. The City reserves the right to determine whether the Adair System can provide adequate service to a potential customer.
3. The location, size and type of pipe to be used for customer service shall be approved in writing by the City prior to installation.
4. The cost of all meters, piping, equipment, labor and overhead shall be paid by the customer. In order to simplify this, it shall be the customer's obligation to arrange for the installation of the service line from the water meter to the service point. All installations shall be to City standards and inspection shall be by City staff.


The cost of the installation of the meter shall be paid in advance and the meter shall be installed by City staff, although labor and/or equipment for such meter installation may be furnished by the customer at the time of installation in order to lessen the cost if so desired.

5. There shall be no resale and/or additional connections for water services from any customer without written approval of the City of Albany.
6. All services shall be protected from cross-connections by means of Oregon State Board of Health approved devices. The cost of such protection shall be paid by the customer.
