RESOLUTION NO. 1750

(Adoption of Neighborhood Planning
Program for City of Albany)

WHEREAS, nine (9) separate neighborhoods have been identified in the City of Albany for the purpose of citizens' participation in the land use planning process, and

WHEREAS, each of the nine (9) separate neighborhoods have been organized as group associations and are functioning with officer and special committee representation, and

WHEREAS, the existing neighborhood planning program is intended to be used as the basis for creating a committee for Citizen Involvement as required by state land use legislation, through the Land Conservation Development Commission and statewide planning goals and guidelines for citizen participation, and


WHEREAS, the formation of a Committee for Citizen Involvement will be used to organize and work with the Citizen Involvement program by adopting the same within the existing neighborhood planning program, now, therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the existing neighborhood planning program be formally recognized by adoption and be used to form a Committee for Citizen Involvement and Citizen Involvement program as required by State of Oregon land use legislation and the Land Conservation Development Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the nine (9) separate neighborhood groups be identified geographically as outlined in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof and particularly identified by the following designations:


Broadway
West Albany
Sunrise
Santiam
Oak
Periwinkle
Jackson-Hill
Central Albany
Willamette
