RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE NOMINATION OF NATIONAL REGISTER HISTORIC DISTRICTS IN THE CITY OF ALBANY.

WHEREAS, the City of Albany possesses a colorful and interesting history much of which is reflected in the buildings and architecture of the community, and,

WHEREAS, the preservation and restoration of such buildings by bringing them to an efficient and contemporary use while respecting the historic and architectural significance of such buildings would contribute to the beautification of the City, the education, enjoyment and pride of its citizens, and the increased economic vitality of the community, and,

WHEREAS, such preservation and restoration would be facilitated by the creation of a National Register Historic District by providing a framework for preservation activities and making economic incentives available to the owners of historic properties, and,


WHEREAS, historic preservation as a strategy for downtown development is compatible with the objectives of the proposed comprehensive plan and has significant support within the community,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, that it supports the concept of historic preservation and asks that the process nominating the Monteith, Hackleman, and Commercial areas of the City as National Register Historic Districts continue subject to the adoption and implementation of the provisions of Ordinance #4235.
