

RESOLUTION NO. 2313

TITLE: MAINTENANCE ON HOUSE LATERALS AND REPEALING RESOLUTIONS NO. 1553 AND 2105

WHEREAS, the City of Albany provides sanitary sewers for the peace, health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and


WHEREAS, house or side laterals are normally provided at the time of construction of the main line sewer. Said house lateral normally extends from the main line sewer to the property line of the benefited property. Said house laterals are being installed to eliminate the need to dig up street improvements at future times; and

WHEREAS, said house laterals are provided for the service of the abutting, benefited properties and for no other reason.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany will no longer do maintenance work or pay for maintenance work done on any house lateral unless it can be determined by the Public Works Director that conditions causing the need for maintenance are due to a definite problem in the main sewer line. A condition attached to the determination of whether or not the fault lies in the main line or not shall be inspected by Public Works personnel prior to any work being done on the house lateral.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution Nos. 1553 and 2105 are hereby repealed.
