

RESOLUTION NO. 2353

ESTABLISHING A 911 EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS PROGRAM WITHIN THE GRANTS FUND AND AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, Chapter 533, Oregon Laws, 1981, requires every public and private safety agency in Oregon to establish or participate in a 911 emergency telephone system; and

WHEREAS, a state-wide three percent telephone tax was established beginning January 1, 1982, to assist jurisdictions in paying for developing or improving a 911 system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany qualifies as a safety agency to participate in a 911 emergency system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Albany, Oregon, that the following 1982-83 budget be entered on the records of the City of Albany and is hereby authorized and approved:


