

# GOALS FOR ALBANY --- 1983-84

## ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

GOAL: CREATE IN COOPERATION WITH THE ALBANY-MILLERSBURG ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, THE ALBANY DOWNTOWN ASSOCIATION, AND OTHERS A LOCAL ECONOMIC ENVIRONMENT WHICH PROMOTES BUSINESS GROWTH AND EXPANSION AND IN WHICH RESIDENTS' NEEDS FOR PRODUCTS, SERVICES, AND STEADY EMPLOYMENT IS REASONABLY ASSURED.

1. Support the growth and expansion of existing business and industry in the urban renewal district, along Pacific Boulevard and Santiam and elsewhere in the community.
2. Attract new commercial and industrial businesses to the community.
3. Promote and facilitate the improvement of the Central Business District as the economic, business, and governmental center of the Albany region.
4. Other.

## PHYSICAL CONDITIONS

GOAL: IMPROVE PHYSICAL CONDITIONS WITHIN THE COMMUNITY TO ENHANCE ALBANY'S APPEARANCE AND LIVABILITY FOR THE BENEFIT OF EXISTING RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES AS WELL AS THOSE WHO WOULD CHOOSE TO LOCATE HERE BECAUSE OF ALBANY'S ATTRACTIVE FEATURES.

1. Provide safe, sanitary, and decent housing for persons of all income levels in a variety of housing types and locations.
2. Establish a city-wide beautification program to improve the appearance of the community.
3. Enhance the three historic districts as community assets.
4. Other.

## PUBLIC SERVICES

GOAL: PROVIDE EFFICIENT AND EFFECTIVE MUNICIPAL SERVICES TO THE CITIZENS OF ALBANY.

1. Construct, operate, and maintain capital facilities to supply services to residents and businesses in the city.
2. Provide residents and businesses with efficient and effective public safety services.
3. Provide municipal services at a level commensurate with community need and ability to pay.
4. Provide opportunities for citizens to be informed about municipal affairs and to effect decisions regarding local services and regulations.
5. Other.

## INTERAGENCY RELATIONS

GOAL: DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN EFFECTIVE WORKING RELATIONSHIPS WITH ALL LEVELS OF GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE AGENCIES WHICH PROVIDE SERVICES TO RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES.

1. Actively participate in the legislative process at the county, state, and federal levels.
2. Cooperate with government agencies providing services to residents and business in the city.
3. Engage the private sector of the economy, both individuals and businesses, in meeting the challenges of a growing community.

1. Monitor properties benefiting from assessment freeze - HAMC
2. Revise demolition ordinance - HAMC
3. Adopt ordinance permitting adaptive use of historic property - HAMC

Capital Facilities

1. Renovation of municipal swimming pool - Parks Dept.
2. Prepare comprehensive revision of Capital Improvement Program for 1984-1990 - Planning Department
3. Complete Wastewater Treatment Plan Facilities Plan - Public Works Department
4. Complete one half of remaining sewer separation program - Public Works Department
5. Complete preliminary City Hall plans & site acquisition - Public Works Department

PUBLIC SERVICES

Public Safety

1. Expand crime prevention program - Police Department
2. Develop residential fire prevention inspection program using volunteer fire fighters - Fire Department
3. Develop increased public awareness of traffic safety practices - Traffic Safety Commission

Needed and Affordable Services

1. Computerize library card catalog to provide access to 3,000 participating libraries and 8 million titles
2. Expand programs offered to teens and handicapped - Recreation Department
3. Extend electronic data processing to line departments - Finance Department

Public Information

1. Develop and implement reports on city purchasing and employee activity - Employee Relations
2. Determine appropriate role for cable TV in providing municipal services and information - City Manager
3. Revitalize citizen participation structures - City Manager

Plans and Strategies

Legislative Affairs

1. Actively participate as members of various League of Oregon Cities committees - All Departments

1. Prepare a countywide plan for a 9-1-1 emergency phone number - Police Department
2. Create a library district serving Linn County - Library
3. Develop joint purchasing procedures for materials and services
4. Participate in revitalization of D4COG - City Manager
5. Renegotiate wastewater treatment agreement with Millersburg - City Manager
6. Develop plan for North Albany sewer service through the ABC Committee

Cooperative Service

1. Increase the number and services of Police Reserves - Police Department
2. Increase use of volunteers to perform nontechnical library tasks - Library
3. Develop corp of volunteers to provide program leadership - Recreation Department
