

RESOLUTION NO. 2597

WHEREAS, Howard Boddy and Dan Kress, former employees of United Foods, are seeking matching funds from the State of Oregon under the provisions of Senate Bill 666 to conduct a pre-feasibility study that might lead to the reopening of the United Foods facility in Albany; and

WHEREAS, the community has experienced a high rate of unemployment since 1980 and there is a real need for additional full time and part time employment which would be provided by the establishment of an agricultural food processing firm,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the efforts by Mr. Boddy and Mr. Kress be supported by the City of Albany and that every effort be made to support their application for funds for a pre-feasibility study and the provision of information and staff time to assist the applicants in the conduct of the necessary studies.
