

RESOLUTION NO. 2729

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PROMPT CONCLUSION OF A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GREATER ALBANY EDUCATION ASSOCIATION AND THE GREATER ALBANY PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, representatives of the Greater Albany Education Association and the Greater Albany Public School District have reached an impasse in their efforts to negotiate a new collective bargaining agreement, and

WHEREAS, the failure to reach such an agreement causes the threat of a teachers' strike to loom over the entire community, and

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council and the entire community, take justifiable pride in the quality of the education experience offered to its students and would hate to see that process interrupted by a divisive strike,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Albany hereby seeks to encourage both sides in these negotiations to reconsider their positions and to resume prompt and meaningful negotiations to resolve the remaining issues in dispute and to promptly reach a new collective bargaining agreement.
