

RESOLUTION NO. 2753

WHEREAS, the City Council acts as the local contract review board; and

WHEREAS, the board can exempt certain purchases from competitive bidding if it makes certain findings; and

WHEREAS, these findings are that the lack of bids will not result in favoritism or substantially diminish competition in awarding the contract; and

WHEREAS, the exemption will result in substantial cost savings.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL FINDS that:

1. There are only two known manufacturers of crack sealing machines.
2. One of the two machines has a substantially shorter heat up time and will reduce City costs substantially because of that.
3. Proposals shall be solicited from all vendors of the approved crack sealing machine within the State of Oregon that can be located.
4. Substantial cost savings will be realized by reducing staff time associated with heating up the material in the machine.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City Council hereby approves the purchase of a crack sealing machine and waives the requirement for competitive bids.
