

RESOLUTION NO. 3357

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (SBA) GRANT FOR FISCAL YEAR 1993-94.

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has received a Small Business Administration grant for the purpose of planting trees in the Lehigh area of Albany; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has removed diseased, damaged, or dead trees from the City right-of-way with no financial means to replace them; and

WHEREAS, this grant provides the financial resources to accomplish the tree planting; and

WHEREAS, this grant requires the use of small businesses to provide the trees and perform the work, and


WHEREAS, conditions of obtaining this grant include a three-year maintenance program of in-kind service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany accepts the Small Business Administration grant in an amount not to exceed \$4,250 for the purpose of planting new curb-side trees in fiscal year 1993-94; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreement and conditions for acceptance.
