

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A MOTOROLA COMMAND PLUS RADIO CONSOLE FROM A SOLE SOURCE VENDOR FOR THE ALBANY POLICE DEPARTMENT.

THE CITY OF ALBANY HEREBY FINDS AS FOLLOWS:


The Albany Police Department received funding for building remodeling, including the communications center, in the FY 93/94 budget. A second dispatch station requiring the purchase of a second radio console is included in the project. The City will purchase a Motorola Command Plus console, Model L1679 with a footswitch and desk microphone from Clackamas Communications. Purchase of this item would be from a sole source vendor for the following reasons:

- ▶ Compatibility with existing equipment.
- ▶ Technical support during and after installation as we currently contract with Motorola service specialist for repairs and maintenance.
- ▶ Clackamas Communications is the only authorized Motorola vendor in the Willamette Valley.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Albany City Council, acting as the Contract Review Board, hereby declares an emergency and authorizes the execution of a contract without competitive bidding as provided for by the provisions of Section 2.64.060 of the Albany Municipal Code, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Albany authorizes the City Manager to purchase a Motorola Command Plus console, Model L1679 with a footswitch and desk microphone from Clackamas Communications for \$6,000 for the new Communications Center in the Albany Police Department.
