

RESOLUTION NO. 3714

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATIONS FOR THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY OREGON EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT.

WHEREAS, the February 1996 flood caused property damage to many Albany citizens; and

WHEREAS, Oregon Emergency Management administers a federal Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) to help local communities in implementing hazard mitigation measures following a major disaster; and


WHEREAS, as a requirement of the HMGP, the City is participating in the Regional Emergency Management Coordinating Council to create a regional mitigation plan; and

WHEREAS, a local match of at least 25 percent of the total cost of the project would be required at the time the grant is awarded; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has identified two potential HMGP projects, "Albany Water Supply Canal Early Flood Warning Project" and "North Albany Storm Drainage Improvements."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council does hereby approve of the submittal of two applications to the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.
