

RESOLUTION NO. 4540

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ACCEPTING THE AWARD OF COPS MORE FUNDS AND A COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE LOCAL MATCHING FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Justice Assistance, of the U.S. Department of Justice, makes grants available through the COPS More program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany Police Department has applied for and received a grant of \$85,000; and

WHEREAS, a local match is required in the amount of 25% of grant award, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to replace aging technology; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds may be used any time before August 31, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds must be directed towards equipment or technology which are in support of basic law enforcement functions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council does hereby state that replacing aging technology is a priority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Albany City Council authorizes the Albany Police Department to accept this COPS More Grant for equipment or technology in the amount of \$85,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following appropriations be made for fiscal year 2001-02:


